## Region Directors Responsibilities

### ★ MEETINGS

- a. Monthly division meeting - all region leaders, assistants, etc.
- b. Regular Region meeting - all stake directors, assistants, high council, etc. These meetings are to provide stakes with area information (i.e. calendars, training, tournaments, firesides, etc.) to teach and train directors in their responsibilities, and to plan region activities.
- c. Coaches meetings - to be held prior to each tournament.
- d. Quarterly region combined meeting (men and women directors)
- e. Firesides - as needed

### ★ CLINICS AND CAMPS (Volleyball, Basketball, Softball, Golf , Futsal & Football)

- a. All sports - a region clinic should be held for all directors, officials, coaches, players, and score keepers prior to each season of play.
- b. Individual stakes may have their own clinics (You may be invited to put on the clinic)
- c. Camps may also be held - these are more intense training for officials (teach and train the first night, then bring teams in the next day to work actual games)

### ★ TOURNAMENTS (all sports)

- a. Set up tournaments - using tournament planning & management
- b. Make sure facilities are scheduled well in advance (have stake leaders schedule their facilities)
- c. Arrange for officiating and score keeping
- d. Make hosting schedule & assignments (equipment, first aid kit, poster, score sheets, pencils, etc.)
- e. Hold coaches meeting and make sure rosters and waivers are all in and correct.
- f. Arrange for awards.
- g. It is always nice to notify stake presidencies and bishops when one of their teams is in a championship game.
- h. Send thank you notes!

### ★ REPORTS

- a. Team registration & tournament planning sheet - to be filled out after each tournament.
- b. Monthly report - (i.e., bring an agenda from region monthly meetings)

### ★ OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES

- a. Set up a 3 year calendar - to give each stake director so they can get region activities on their own stakes calendars and schedule their facilities for tournaments.
- b. Visit your stakes - show your support by visiting games in each stake you are over; observe quality of officiating and note who will do well in your region tournament.
- c. Be a resource
  - Help leaders get equipment - such as balls, whistles, score cards, officials, shirts, posters, rule books, etc.
  - Help with training when needed; offer suggestions when asked for; express encouragement; and give compliments when deserved.
- d. Encourage sportsmanship, be a good example, and always ask the Lord for His help.
